

Instructions for authors of abstracts for proceedings

By tradition, we publish the proceedings from the meetings of the Scandinavian and Dutch national societies and the biennial congress of the Scandinavian Orthopedic Association. In addition, we may accept proceedings from subspecialty societies and research meetings.

The abstracts will be scanned and edited and should for optimal readability be prepared as follows:

- Double spaced, typewritten with carbon-band or laserprinted, standing A4, maximum 1 page (200 words).
- Use fonts without serif (i.e. Helvetica) or widely spaced letters.
- Write the abstract in English.
- Line one: Title of paper. Do not use capital letters only.
- Line two: Full names of the authors with the speaker's name first. No titles.
- Line three: Institution or department, city, and country.
- Line four: Empty.
- Line five and on: The abstract.
- Each abstract should, if possible, include the headings *Introduction, Materials (Patients) and methods, Results, Conclusion*.
- Figures, tables, and references are accepted.
- Figures should be suitable for reproduction in 7.0-cm width.
- Submit two copies and glossy prints of figures.
