

CURRICULUM VITAE

The author was born on 30 th May 1947 in Amsterdam, the Netherlands. After graduating from secondary school in 1964, he studied Medicine at the State University Leiden, qualifying in March 1972 (cum laude). During 1972 he worked at the Orthopaedic Department, Municipal Hospital the Hague (head Dr P.J. Moll), followed by a scholarship at the Laboratory for Anatomy and Embryology, where the basis for this thesis was laid in collaboration with Prof. Dr A. Huson and Ir C.W. Spoor. In 1973 he fulfilled his military service at the Ministry of Defence in the Hague, department I.G.D.K.L.

From 1974 to 1976 he received specialist training in General Surgery at the Municipal Hospital in the Hague (head Dr. J.D. Bom).

From 1976 to 1980 he received his training in orthopaedic surgery from Dr P.J. Moll and Dr J. Tissink, also at the Municipal Hospital in the Hague, during which time half a year he was trained at the Red Cross Hospital at the Hague by Mr. J.D. de Mol van Otterloo and Mr. W. Moll, orthopaedic surgeons. Since May 1980 he is working as an orthopaedic surgeon at the St. Elisabeth Hospital in Leiderdorp (formerly Leiden), in association with the orthopaedic surgeons Mr. J.C. Baijens and Mr. A. Ebbink.
